



Vaccine Update # 478 - GSK expiry dates correction


Correction for Vaccine Update 477: GSK expiry dates

[Vaccine Update 477](#) discussed the different expiry dates in some GSK vaccines which are composed of a syringe and a vial.

Key points:

1. Please note that the batch number on the box and the syringe or vial may be different.
2. Please refer to the expiry date and batch number on the box when recording vaccination data into the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR), because this is the correct detail for the product as a whole. Do not use the batch number on the vial or syringe.
3. Please store all immunisations in their original packaging with the packaging closed until the time of vaccine administration to avoid confusion.

Refer to the batch number and expiry date on the BOX for product expiry and for reporting to the AIR



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
