0719/36 Elevated troponin

WA Coding Rule 0712/02 *Elevated troponin* is retired.

In ICD-10-AM/ACHI/ACS Seventh Edition (effective 1 July 2010) an ICD-10-AM Index entry was created for abnormal troponin serum level. This change was inadvertently missed in the 2018 review of WA Coding Rules.

DECISION

WA Coding Rule 0712/02 *Elevated troponin* is retired.

Can you please confirm that elevated troponin is now coded to R74.8 *Abnormal levels of other serum enzymes*?

A.

Abnormal level of troponin is listed in the description under R74.8 *Abnormal levels of other serum enzymes*. This was a 7th edition change.

Coders should ignore any previous advice on how to code elevated troponin and code to R74.8 *Abnormal levels of other serum enzymes*.

DECISION

Elevated Troponin should be coded to R74.8 *Abnormal levels of other serum enzymes*.
