ACCD Coding Rule ***Multiple delivery by same method*** (Ref No: TN1248) was retired on 30 June 2019.

If twins are both born via SVD do we code 90467-00 once or twice?

A.

Twin delivery with SVD (both twins) requires 90467-00 Spontaneous Vertex Delivery to be assigned twice. This is required to enable counting of spontaneous vertex deliveries in WA for reporting purposes. Please refer to the WA Coding Standards for further information.

DECISION

Assign 90467-00 Spontaneous Vertex Delivery twice.
