# Western Australian Coding Rule

## **0722/07 Killer T-Cell infusion**

In ICD-10-AM/ACHI/ACS Twelfth Edition, new ACHI blocks have been created for Cell therapies and Gene therapies, these include Natural Killer T-cells. An Includes note for T-cells NOS and Tumour-infiltrating lymphocyte (TIL) therapy has also been added to 13706-04 [1893].



# Western Australian Coding Rule

## 0719/09 Killer T-Cell infusion

WA Coding Rule 0713/06 *Killer T-Cell infusion* is retired.

In ICD-10-AM/ACHI/ACS Eleventh Edition (effective 1 July 2019) an ACHI Alphabetic Index entry was created for T-cell therapy.

# Western Australian Coding Rule

## 0713/06 Killer T-Cell infusion

### Q.

What is the procedure code for patients admitted for infusion of Killer T-Cells?

Possible codes: 13706-04 [1893] *Administration of leukocytes* and 13706-10 [802] *Allogenic bone marrow or stem cell transplantation, other donor, with in vitro processing*

### A.

Killer T-cells (lymphocytes) are infused as they target abnormal cells (cancer). Follow the index pathway:

Infusion

-leukocyte and assign 13706-04 [1893] *Administration of leukocytes*.

### DECISION

**Assign 13706-04 [1893] *Administration of leukocytes for infusion of Killer T-Cells*.**
