
WA Falls Action Plan



A range of services are available in WA to deliver falls prevention interventions. The WA Falls Action Plan represents an overarching approach to falls prevention in different settings. The red items demonstrate population health strategies, the orange items are services involved in screening, referring and assessing and the green items are the types of available interventions and where they are delivered. Multicoloured items are an indication of the dual role of these behaviours or services i.e. exercise can be promoted as both a general population health strategy and also an individualised intervention for people at risk of falls. Further discussion of each service is outlined in the Falls Prevention Model of Care.
